Parent & Player Commitments

Time

- 1-year team commitment prioritized above all other nonacademic activities
- 2 practices per week
- > Arrive on time for practices and games (including warmup)
- > EXTRA Fall season begins August and ends January-March
- CSL Spring season (club circuit) and/or Tournaments January through the end of May.

Financial

- > \$325, plus \$25 NPF due at registration in May. There are no refunds.
- > Includes home/away kits, practice kit, warm ups & bag.
- > Tournament fees (parent paid or fundraised)

Volunteer

- > Each player must provide one relative/friend to referee.
- > EXTRA teams must fill 6 spots for every home game.

Travel

- > 5/6 home games and 5/6 away games
- > EXTRA plays in circuits throughout Sections 1, 10 & 11

Dismissal

- Players, parents, and coaches shall exemplify the highest standard of AYSO's Six Philosophies
- ➤ Removal from team may result from poor practice attendance, habitually arriving late to or missing games, poor sportsmanship, poor behavior by spectators present on player's behalf, or persistent disrespectful behavior towards coaches, parents, players, or referees.
- ➤ Players are required to return all gear in the event of leaving the team before the completion of the 1-year commitment.
